## Performance notes

Dashed slurs (e.g. bar 13-14) indicate that no breath should be taken.

Where no tie is indicated for the same pitches on the same vowel (e.g. tenor bar 9), the notes should be rearticulated, and slightly separated so that the rhythm can be felt (i.e. the B-B notes should be sung as e q. and not h in this case).
